An operating high level switch stand. The design is patterned after the type used by the Milwaukee Road and many other railroads. The stand is made of delrin and is supplied with ABS targets.


Look at these features:

- Direct connection to the turnout through molded-on pins on the slide bar.
- A pin on either end of the slide bar permits selective mounting positions for the most favorable handle swing.
- A stop and lock at both ends of the throw.
- 180° handle rotation turns the target 90° through small gears.
- Six paintable, bondable ABS targets including a lantern and square/diamond select your favorites.
- Enough .025" dia. (#22 wire) rod for an eight-foot high target. Cut to your desired length.
- Provisions made so targets can be made to operate from electrical machines below the table on electrically controlled turnouts.

Like our ground throws, the high levels are available with both the rigid and the internally sprung slide bar. In the 204S, internal stainless steel springs will take up the overtravel and maintain tension to hold the points against the stock rails of the turnout. The molded-on pins and the internal springs make the model 204S easy to mount to any turnout.



NOW IMPROVED!

A detent has been added to the rotary action that assists in holding the handle straight out parallel to the base. This makes it much easier to grasp the handle for operation.



Look at some of the other advantages of the CABOOSE INDUSTRIES ground throw switch stands.

- Molded of strong, self-lubricating black delrin.
- Maximum life and throw because the unique external cam provides parallel constant area surfaces between the cam and the slotted rib.
- Direct connection to the turnout through a molded-on pin on the slide bar.
- Special small holes permit spring wire connection without excessive play.
- Positive lock on both ends of the throw. The lock operates from 10 degrees above horizontal to the extreme down position.
- Straight line throw is aided by the finger grip shape on the handle.

Additionally---the 202S is internally sprung!
Internal stainless steel springs take up the overtravel and maintain tension to hold the points against the stock rails of the turnout. The tension and overtravel perform well with all commercial turnouts and with scratch-built turnouts. Internal springs and the moded-on pin make Model 202S easy to mount to the turnout.

The 101R is an operational switch stand, but does require the fabrication of connecting spring. It provides over 3/16" of positive throw movement.
